- Case 1. CSVP 2011-2654 (100-051A, Tainan City Animal Health Inspection and Protection Office, J.T. Liu, Y.C. Yang, W.C. Chuang, C.C. Lee, S.S. Tsai)**
Piglet, 10-day-old, showed signs of weakness and scab covered the skin with bad smell and greasy texture. No other lesion was noted in necropsy. The mobility was 0.3% (4/1,500) and motility was zero.
- Case 2. CSVP 2011-2655 (Q99-155, Pingtung county LDCC, M.T. Tsai, W.L. Chen, C.H. Hsaio, S.T. Huang, J.P. Hsu, and Chung-Hwa animal hospital in Pingtung, Y.Y. Kuo)**
Canine, 6-year-old, male, mongrel, showed clinical signs of vomiting emaciation, diarrhea, lethargy, reluctant to move, bilaterally symmetrical alopecia, and gynecomastia. An abdominal mass near stomach, about 7x6x5 cm in size, was surgically excised for pathological diagnosis.
- Case 3. CSVP 2011-2656 (P99119, Kaohsiung City Animal Protection Office, W.C. Chen, C.T. Wu, C.B. Chao, C.D. Zhu)**
Growing pig, 30-50 kgs, showed the clinical signs of languish, inability to stand, persistent screaming and myoclonia with a compelled movement. These symptoms were noted after the owner changed a new batch of feed which tiamulin was added for 3-5days. The mortality was about 30%.
- Case 4. CSVP 2011-2657 (pb10003098, UNI-PRESIDENT ENTERPRISES CORP., H.C. Huang, W.C. Lee)**
Layer, showed signs of depression, pale comb, diarrhea with green droppings and 2-3% increase of soft shell eggs. Gross findings showed white dots in visceral epicardium, liver and hemorrhagic dots in kidney.
- Case 5. CSVP 2011-2658 (OT-10472, NPUST, S.M. Wong, T.C. Chang, C.D. Chang, H.C. Wang, S.S. Tsai)**
Melon-headed whale (瓜頭鯨), male, immature, was stranded and rescued for seventeen days with clinical signs of weakness, body wasting, and poor appetite.
- Case 6. CSVP 2011-2659 (D100-20721, NPUST, P.Y. Tu, T.C. Chang, C.D. Chang, H.C. Wang, S.S. Tsai)**
Pig, 10-week-old, showed clinical signs of dyspnea, ataxia and convulsion.
