**Case 1. CSVP 2011-2660 ( 1000513FB6, Hsinchu county LDCC, C.Y. Teng, J.H. Peng)**

Pomadasys Kaakan (星雞魚), from the sea fishing, showed signs of floating dock, body discoloration, and the skin ulcers. Although the total amount was unknown, the fishes were 100% died after being caught.

**Case 2. CSVP 2011-2661 (100-040c, NLAC, Y.L. Chen, T.Y. Chen, K.H. Lee, C.T. Liang)**

Canine, Schnauzer, 2-year-old, male. One soft skin mass (4.5\*2.5\*2.5 cm) was noted on the back for more than one month. FNA: coccus, and some WBCs. Surgical excision was performed. The specimen was submitted for histopathology.

**Case 3. CSVP 2011-2662 (2009-2057-24, AHRI, Y.C. Tu, K.R. Tsai, J.C. Chang, W.C. Hsu, S.H. Lee)**

Cattle, Holstein, 1-year-old, showed signs of poor body condition, diarrhea and swelling on right mandible with skin ulceration.

**Case 4. CSVP 2011-2663 (NTU2010-756A, NTU, Y.C. Ting, P.H. Chang)**

Panthera onca(美洲豹), 17-year-old, female, showed signs of anemia and the mass located within the back abdomen was noted.

**Case 5. CSVP 2011-2664 (NTU2010-850E, NTU, H.S. Chiou, C.R. Jeng)**

Amazona autumnalis (紅眼亞馬遜鸚鵡), 24-year-old, male, showed signs of poor vigor. The patient was quarantined and treated on 2010/10/25. However, the patient was still inactive and anorexia. Force feeding for the animal was difficult to administrate and the patient was dead on the next morning.

**Case 6. CSVP 2011-2665 (NTU2011-847, NTU, H.S. Liang, C.R. Jeng)**

Domestic cat, DSH, 6-year-old, had intermittent vomiting for 2 month with normal appetite and spirit. The progressive weight loss was noted. There were some mass can be palpated in abdomen.
