Case 1. CSVP 2012-2672 (Q100-253, Pingtung county LDCC, M.T. Tsai, W.L. Chen, C.H. Hsaio, S.T. Huang, J.P. Hsu)

Suckling piglets, 15-day-old, LYD type, showed clinical signs of lethargy, anorexia, respiratory distress, diarrhea, and recumbency with paddling.

Case 2. CSVP 2012-2673 (100-F293A, Tainan City Animal Health Inspection and Protection Office, J.T. Liu, W.C. Chuang, C.C. Lee)

Loach, approximately 15 to 25 cm in length, the examination revealed pus and ulcer on their body and gill disease was also noted.

Case 3. CSVP 2012-2674 (P100081, Kaohsiung City Animal Protection Office, W. C. Chen, C.T. Wu and C.B. Chao)

Broiler breeder, 17-week-old, showed clinical signs of anorexia and dyspnea. It was failed with therapy. Varying size of white mass through the lung, heart and spleen were noted in post mortem examination.

Case 4. CSVP 2012-2675 (pb10008190, UNI-PRESIDENT ENTERPRISES CORP., H.C. Huang, W.C. Lee)

Simulated native chicken, breeder, 37-week-old, showed signs of depression, dyspnea and swollen of bilateral infraorbital sinus.

Case 5. CSVP 2012-2676 (WA100-2553, NPUST, M.C. Lee, H.C. Wang, S.S. Tsai, M.T. Chiou, J.C. Pei, C.D. Chang, T.C. Chang)

Formosan macaque (*Macaca cyclopis*), 12-year-old, female, showed clinical signs of genital and facial hemorrhages.

Case 6. CSVP 2012-2677 (D100-20898, NPUST, H.K. Chang, H.C. Wang, C.H. Chien, S.S. Tsai, M.T. Chiou, C.D. Chang, T.C. Chang)

Canine, mongrel, 5-year-old, male, a volcano-like, 2 x 2 x 1.5 cm in diameter mass was found on the left hard palate. This mass is slightly-firm, dark-red covered with blood-like on the surface. On radiography and CT scan, this mass invaded into the nasal cavity.
