**Case 1. CSVP 2012-2685 (CM168, NCYU, Z.L. Cai, H.C. Kyo, D.Y. Lo)**

Growing pig, 10-week-old, showed clinical signs of lethargy, anorexia, ruffle hair, and respiratory distress. The mobility was 10% (12/120) and motility was 5% (6/120).

**Case 2. CSVP 2012-2686 (NAA09-101, TACTRI, L. H. Chang and C.H. Yang)**

SD rat, two-year-old, female, showed signs of rough coat and weakness. A palpable mass about 8x6x4 cm near the left flank region were noted at necropsy.

**Case 3. CSVP 2012-2687 (CW11-014c, GIVP, NCHU, S.J. Wu, C.A. Wu, F.T. Chan, L.M. Wang, W.F. Chang, J.W. Liao)**

Leopard cat, 3-year-old, housed, male, had shown signs of anorexia and emaciated for days. Chest X ray showed locally extensive, cloud shadows with increase of intensity in the bilateral lungs.

**Case 4. CSVP 2012-2688 (CM12-0101B, ADDC NCHU, I.S. Lai, S.H. Huang, W.F. Chang)**

Suckling piglet, 1-week-old, showed dander and damp skin. Morbidity 20-30%.

**Case 5. CSVP 2012-2689 (CO11-1221, IVP NCHU, Y.C. Lai, Y.F. Liu, H.C. Wang, D.X. Chen, W.C. Lee)**

Piglets, 1~2-day-old, showed bloody diarrhea. Both morbidity and mortality were very low.

**Case 6. CSVP 2012-2690 (CO11-1093, IVP NCHU, W.H. Yah, D.Y. Wu, C.C. Lin)**

Canine, British bull, adult, female, showed intensive watery diarrhea and vomiting for a month. She was euthanized finally after many kinds of medication and treatment, but no remarkable improvement.

**Case 7. CSVP 2012-2691 (CO11-1043H, IVP NCHU, C.R. Lin, D.Y. Wu, C.C. Lin)**

Canine, miniature Schnauzer, 9-year-old, intact female, showed vomiting for a week. A large abdominal mass originated from stomach, beside the spleen. The mass lightly adhered to nearby organs such as: duodenum, greater omentum, intestinal and abdominal wall. The stomach was hard and thickened in palpation.
