Case 1. CSVP 2012-2692 (Q101-42, Pingtung county LDCC, M.T. Tsai, W.L. Chen, C.H. Hsaio, S.T. Huang, J.P. Hsu)

Goose, White Roman type, 30-day-old, showed clinical signs of growth retardation, greenish diarrhea and lameness.

Case 2. CSVP 2012-2693 (P100155, Kaohsiung City Animal Protection Office, W.C. Chen, C.B. Chao, S.Y. Ko)

Rabbit, about 1-year-old, showed the clinical signs of dyspnea, anorexia, depression and failure of oral therapy with sulfamethoxazole/trimethoprim. The mortality was about 5%.

Case 3. CSVP 2012-2694 (SP-5529, NPUST, C.H. Chu, C.D. Chang, T.C. Chang, H.C. Wang)

Canine, shiba inu (柴犬), 12-year-old, male, showed clinical signs of vomition and anorexia. Multiple, variably-sized, irregularly-shaped cavities were randomly scattered in the liver on ultrasonography.

Case 4. CSVP 2012-2695 (SP101-5530, NPUST, C.C. Hsu, C.D. Chang, T.C. Chang, H.C. Wang)

Canine, siberian husky (西伯利亞哈士奇犬), 12-year-old, male, showed multiple masses around anus.

Case 5. CSVP 2012-2696 (D100-21153, NPUST, H.K. Chang, H.C. Wang, C.D. Chang, T.C. Chang)

Canine, mongrel, 4-month-old, intact female, showed clinical signs of liver dysfunction, mild icterus, anemia, and coagulopathy.

Case 6. CSVP 2012-2697 (S2012-0012b, ATIT, C.W. Cheng, K.J. Cheng, G.L. Chang, S.G. Chen, Y.J. Tseng, Hans Chen)

Canine, mongrel, 10-year-old, female, was found to bear a mass in the hind right limb on October 20, 2011. The mass was excised and the dog was treated with antibiotic and steroid. Recurrence of the tumor was noted in December with a rapid growing up to 6*6*2 cm in size. New tumor mass, 5*3*2 cm, was observed in the right inguinal region. Surgical excision of these two masses was performed on December 30, 2011.
