Case 1. CSVP 2013-2754 (PG102-007, Fisheries Research Institute, C.C. Chang)

Horseshoe crabs, 9-year-old, unknown sex, gradual death after floating on the water. The morbidity was 6~20 thousands and the mortality was about 50% after treatment.

Case 2. CSVP 2013-2755 (H97-640-3, NLAC, CT Liang)

Mouse, adult, wet tissues were submitted for pathological diagnosis.

Case 3. CSVP 2013-2756 (2013-994-21 & 22, AHRI, YC Tu, KR Tsai, JC Chang, WC Hsu and SH Lee)

Cattle, Holstein, 42-day-old, female, had respiratory signs. The inter-ventricular septal defect in the heart was found at necropsy.

Case 4. CSVP 2013-2757 (NTU2012-1944, GIMCP, NTU, YC Liao, VF Pang)

Feline, DSH, 10-year-old, castrated male, had chronic vomiting with dark brown fluid since 2012/11/8. Normal blood exam and positive result of the fPL test (testing for panniculitis) was detected. Barium study was unremarkable. Laparotomy found a mass near the pylorus.

Case 5. CSVP 2013-2758 (NTU2012-1919, GIMCP, NTU, CC Lin, VF Pang)

Canine, mongrel, 14-year-old, castrated male, had non-painful, firm, well defined skin masses around left prescapular area since 4.5 years ago, and enlarged gradually. The mass had been excised in last year and diagnosed as lipoma, and grew up again at the same site rapidly and became 20×20×8 cm. The mass was attached to the muscle, soft and unencapsulated.

Case 6. CSVP 2013-2759 (NP-557A, GIMCP, NTU, J.W. Jiang, C.H. Liu)

Canine, Schnauzer, 7.5-year-old, intact male, was noted hematuria for a month, and was refractory to medical treatment. Because the dog also had unilateral, abdominal cryptorchidism, so the veterinarian suggested castration and cystocentesis for urine culture at the same time.
